

# WORD FAMILY SNOWPEOPLE

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print out the snowpeople templates and cut out the shapes. They make four snowpeople with top hats.
2. Form snowpeople by stacking three circles. The biggest circles go on the bottom, the medium ones in the middle, and the smallest on top for heads. Use the heads with faces already drawn, or draw your own faces on the extra heads provided.
3. Add a top hat to each snowperson, then glue your people onto pieces of paper or tape them together on the back of the shapes.
4. The smallest circles, with words on them, are the buttons. Help your child glue buttons onto each snowperson. Match the words to the right word family. For example, “man” should go on the snowperson with the hat that says “an.”
5. **Bonus:** Help your child come up with their own rhyming words from the word families to write on the blank buttons.
